An international program with a daily schedule that rivals a professional company in the amount of hours spent in the studio and the supervised independence of campus living, Milwaukee Ballet's Summer Intensive Program provides the opportunity for tremendous technical, artistic, and personal growth in each student.

Pre-Professional Summer Program

Six Weeks: June 20–July 29, 2011

An intense, comprehensive course for serious pre-professionals age 11 and up who have attained a high intermediate to advanced level of ballet technique. Ladies must have a minimum of one full year of intensive pointe training.

Tuition: \$2,400 | Room & Board (optional, per person): Double Room \$2,400, Single Room \$2,500

Due March 15, 2011 | Registration Fee (\$25) + Tuition Deposit (\$300) + Room & Board Deposit (\$300)

Due May 16, 2011 | All remaining tuition and dormitory balance

Registration Fee and deposits are non-refundable

Intermediate Summer Program

Three Weeks: July 11–29, 2011

An intense course for intermediate students age 11 and up. Ladies must have started pointe work no later than September 2010.

Tuition: \$1,500 | Room & Board (optional, per person): Double Room \$1,500, Single Room \$1,500

Due March 16, 2011 | Registration Fee (\$25) + Tuition Deposit (\$300) + Room & Board Deposit (\$300)

Due May 16, 2011 | All remaining tuition and dormitory balance

Registration Fee and deposits are non-refundable

Audition Requirements and Placement

To audition for either program ladies must have started pointe work no later than September, 2010. The audition consists of a 90-minute master ballet class (\$30 fee). Registration begins 30 minutes prior to auditions. **It is recommended** to download, print, and complete the Audition Registration Form online at www.milwaukeeballet.org, and bring it to the audition. Video auditions are accepted and requirements are listed online. Audition results determine acceptance into the appropriate program, and level if placed into the Pre-Professional program. Audition results are emailed within ten days of each audition. The first day of the Pre-Professional program is a placement audition. The Intermediate program consists of one level for all students.

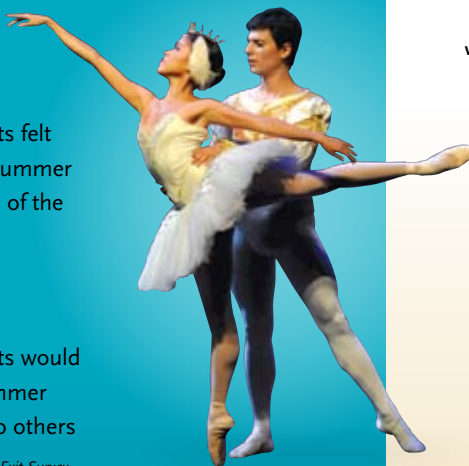
